

An Angel Visits Mary

Soon after that, Mary went to visit Elizabeth, who was her relative. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, she felt her baby move within her.




Then Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and said, "You are the most blessed of all women. And blessed is the child you will bear."
