
Jesus' Trial Before Pilate




Early the next morning after questioning Jesus, the being defiled.

So Pilate came out and asked, "What charges do you bring against this man?" The priests said, "If he were not a criminal, we would not have brought him. But we cannot execute anyone."






The crowd shouted, "No, not him! Give us Barabbas!" (Barabbas was a Jew who had been arrested for taking part in a rebellion.)






But Pilate said, "You take him and crucify him. I find no basis for a charge against him." The priests said, "Our law says he must die, because he claimed to be the Son of God."




Then Pilate sat on his judgment seat and brought Jesus to him. "Here is your king!" he said to the people. "Take him away," they shouted. "Crucify him!"
