

Pharaoh's Dream



While Joseph was still in prison in Egypt, something happened which changed his life and the future of all Egypt.




One night Pharaoh had a very disturbing dream. The next morning he became very worried about what the dream might mean.


"Soon afterward I had another dream. Seven plump ears of grain sprouted from a stalk, followed by seven withered ears. The withered ears ate up the plump ears!"


Seeing Pharaoh's dismay, Joseph added, "I would suggest that Pharaoh find a wise man to help the country prepare for this emergency."
