
## **Moses on Mount Sinai**



Moses came down and told the Israelites to get ready to worship God. "Be ready by the day after tomorrow," he said. "When the trumpet sounds, we must go to the mountain."




Moses led them out of the camp to meet God. They stood at the foot of the mountain. All the people trembled violently, as the trumpet sounds got louder and louder.
