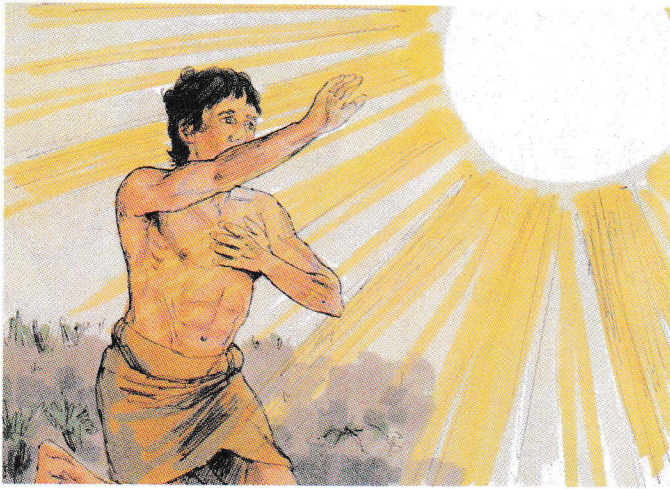
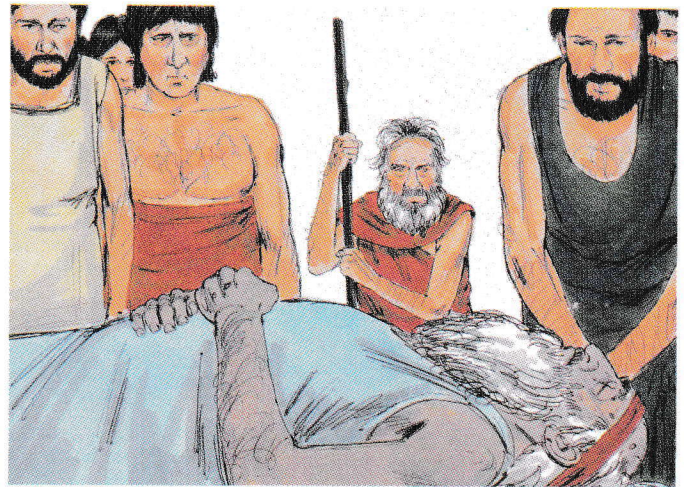


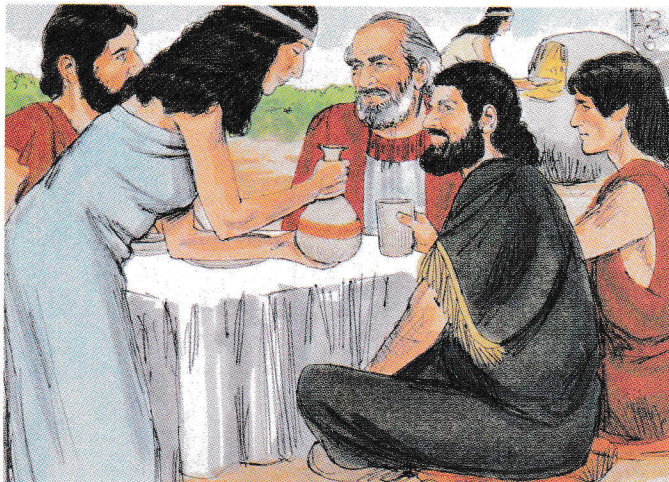
God Sends a Flood



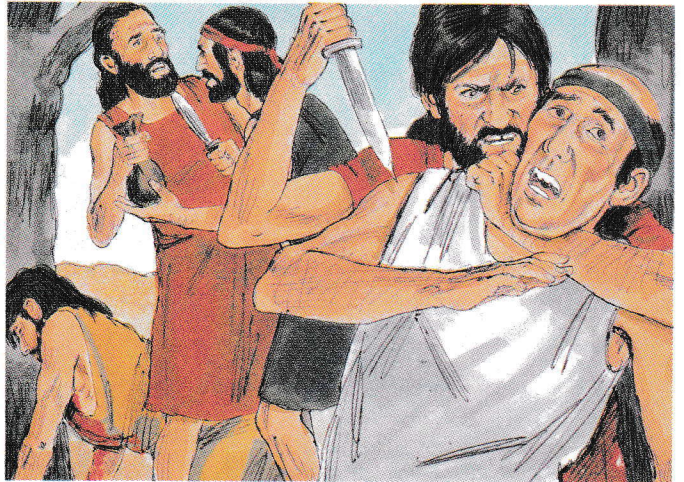
1 After Cain killed his brother Abel and was sent away, Adam and Eve had many other children.



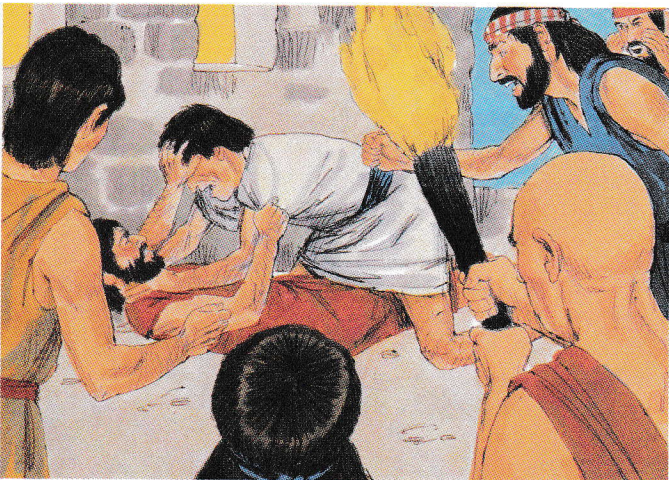
2 In those days people lived to be very, very old. But no matter how long people lived, everyone had to die sooner or later. No one could escape death forever.



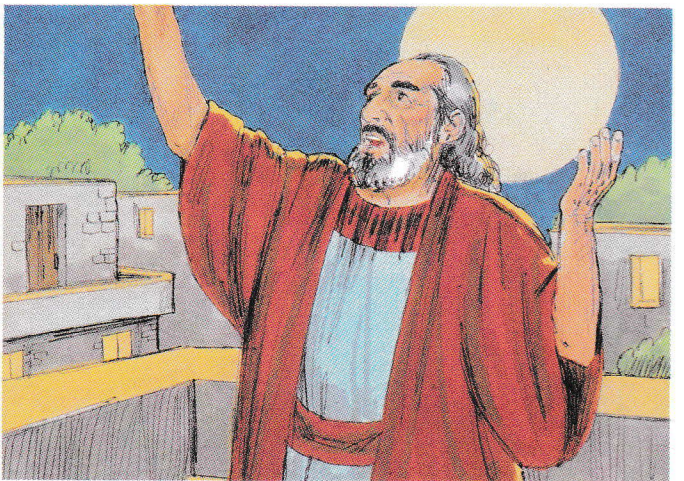
3 There was a man named Noah living then. He was an old man with three sons. Their names were Shem, Ham, and Japheth.



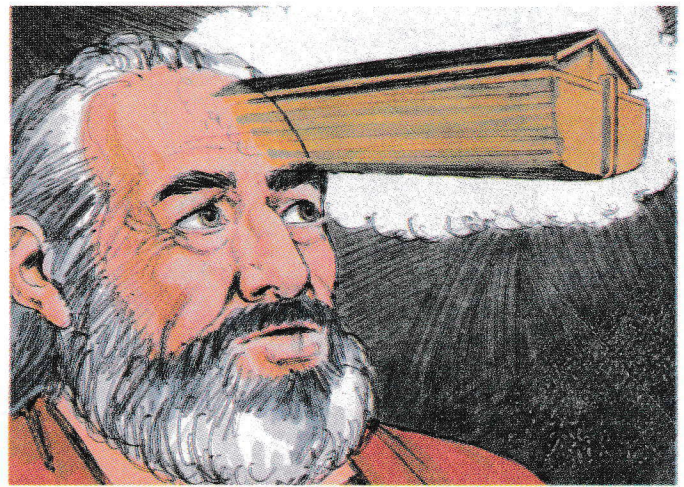
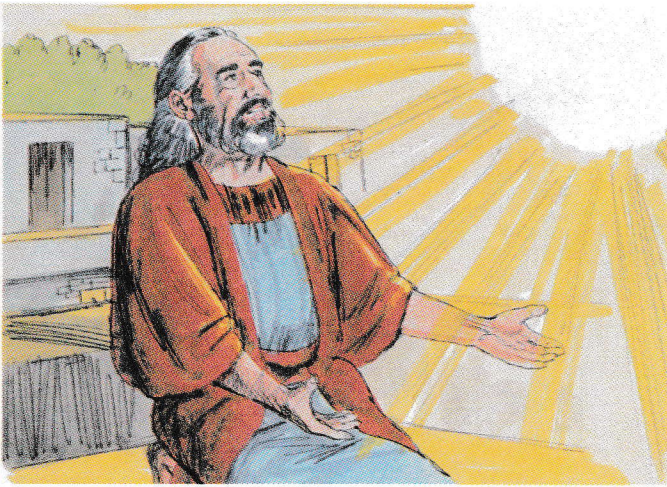
4 People were doing very evil things in Noah's day. It seemed as though the more people there were, the more wicked people became.



5 Finally, people's wickedness became so great that God was sorry he had ever made them. He decided to destroy all the people living on the earth who did not obey him.

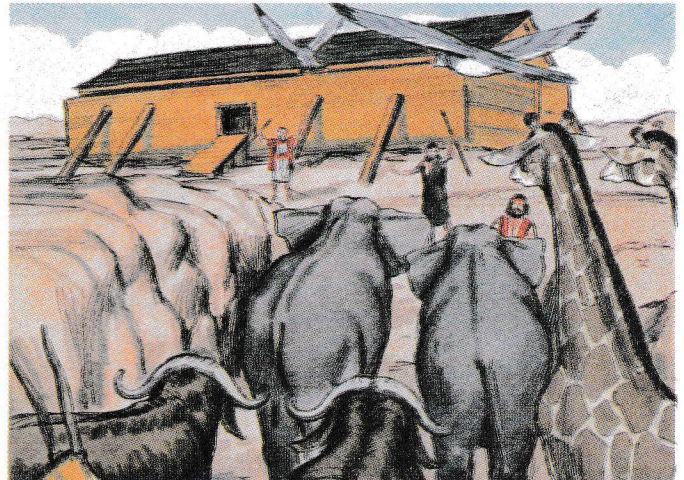
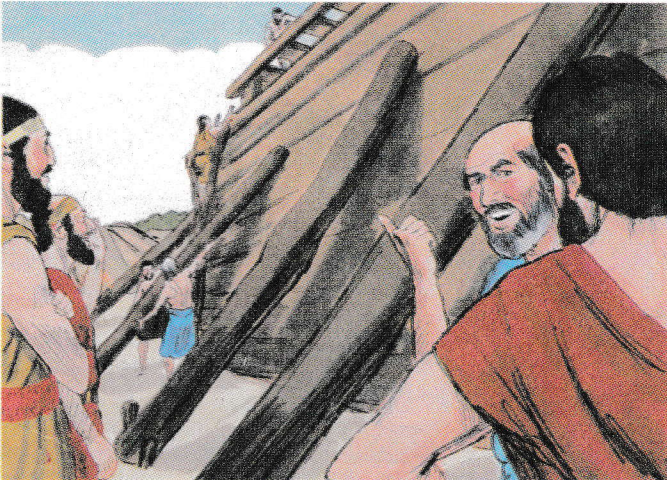


6 However, there was one man whom God planned to save—Noah. He was the only person living in those days who was not evil. Noah was a good man who loved God.



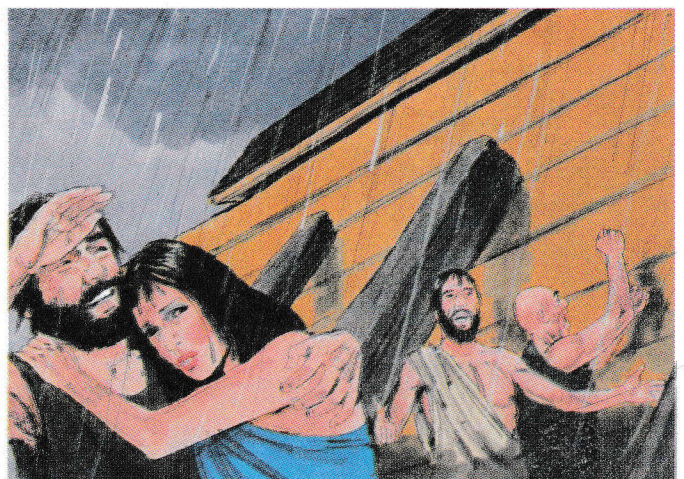
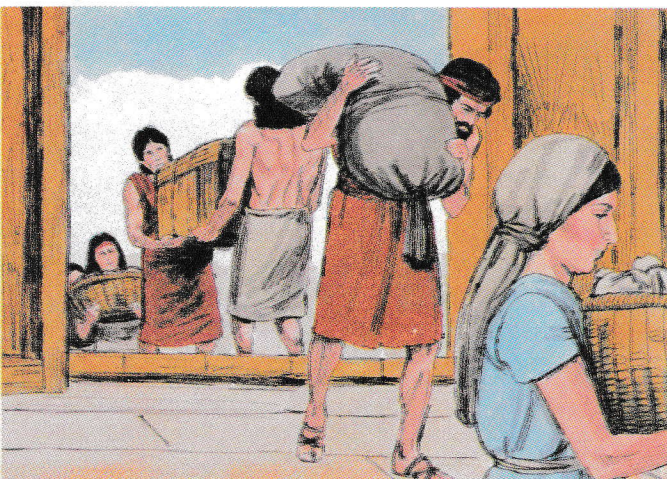
