Elijah in the Whirlwind





As the fifty prophets watched, Elijah took off his cloak and hit the water with it. The water divided! Elijah and Elisha walked across on dry ground!




On the other side of the Jordan, Elijah asked Elisha, "What shall I do for you before I am taken away?" Elisha answered, "Please give me a double share of your spirit."
