
The Fiery Furnace

At the ceremony a servant announced, "The king commands that when the music begins, everyone must bow down and worship the statue. Anyone who does not will be thrown into a furnace."




So when they heard the sound of the musical instruments, all the officials of the empire bowed down and worshiped the golden statue. That is, all but Daniel's three friends.
