
God Tests Abraham




When Abraham was 100 years old, Sarah gave birth to a son. This was the child God had promised Abraham and Sarah for so long.




Abraham named the child Isaac. When Isaac was eight days old, Abraham circumcised him, just as God had commanded.

Early the next morning, Abraham cut wood for the sacrifice and loaded it on his donkey. He took Isaac and two servants and started out for the mountain which God had described.






Abraham had Isaac carry the wood for the sacrifice, while he himself carried a knife and live coals for starting the fire.

Just as Abraham raised the knife to kill his son, the angel of the Lord stopped him. The angel said, "Don't hurt the boy. Now I know that you honor God."




Then God said, "I, the Lord, will richly bless you because you did not keep back even your only son from me."
